
Confessions

Spaces: 2-20, 65-102, & 152-171 only.


Parking privileges end on: Saturday – 8:00pm

Sunday-6:45pm

Go to the KIOSK and:

- 1) Touch any key on the key pad
- 2) License plate? Put in your license plate letters and digits...PRESS OK
- 3) Kiosk will then ask you to choose time. Press #4 for Holy Ghost...PRESS OK
- 4) Screen Prompts Enter Code...
- 5) Enter 1312 ... PRESS OK
- 6) Kiosk prints out dashboard ticket.

Put the ticket inside your car on the dashboard face up!


