Religious Education General Information, 2024-2025

Welcome to our Holy Ghost Religious Education program! We are happy to have you and your family participating and are committed to helping you prepare for the Sacraments and deepen your spiritual life and family formation. Our teachers are volunteer parishioners who have fulfilled the Archdiocesan requirement of Safe Environment training and have had a background check administered by a third party.

This year we will be offering classes at 2 Levels, plus OCIC*. **Year 1** would correspond to Second Grade; and **Year 2** to Third Grade: and ***OCIC** is for children past the age of reason (usually 7) <u>who have not</u> yet received Baptism. Please note that children must be enrolled based on which Sacraments they have received, rather than their age.

Therefore, we are prepared to adapt each curriculum to meet the needs of any older children who enroll.

- Year 1 (Sacramental preparation) Salvation history, preparation for First Confession/Reconciliation
- Year 2 (Sacramental preparation) Preparation for Confirmation and First Holy Communion + OCIC—Preparation for Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion at Easter Vigil
- Unlike recent years, **Faith Formation** classes will be offered on **Sundays only**, following the 8:30am Mass (9:45am) until about 11:25am.
- We still require that each child be accompanied by at least one parent during each class in keeping the family together in the journey of faith formation.
- The Archdiocese of Denver requires age-appropriate Safe Environment Training to be completed each Year in the Fall.

Please note *Restored Order* for Sacramental Prep for Confirmation & First Communion in religious education is a *two-year program* and the OCIC / Special Sacraments track is for children past the age of reason (age 7); and Special Sacraments are for those who have been Baptized and still need to receive Reconciliation, Confirmation and First Eucharist in grades 4-5 (Grades 6-12 Contact Fr. Paul).

Parent/Child Meeting will begin the weekend of Sunday, September 8, 2024 for Parents(+Child) for Introductions + Meet Teachers and to receive books. Classes begin September 15. **First Confessions** will be made in the spring before Easter. Children may go to Confession with any of the priests from Holy Ghost, either by appointment or during a regularly scheduled confession time. The priest should be told that it is a first time Confession, and parents should notify the director of religious education of their child's First Confession. A Retreat for Confirmation and First Communion will be held in March, and the sacraments will be celebrated on Tuesday evening, April 29, 2025. Older children will be baptized and confirmed at the Easter Vigil, March 30, 2025. More details will follow.

Program Cost: \$40 for one child, \$70 for two children, or \$90 for three or more children in a family.
