WEEKLY REFLECTION

Well, I think everyone is happy that the election is finally over. It's no secret that this election has been a source of great anxiety and frustration for many people, and the uncertainty of it all had the entire country biting its nails. Now, like them or not, the results are in, and we can take a deep breath, knowing that at the very least the uncertainty is resolved.

While this election is over, it is fruitful for us to reflect on the meaning of the word "election," and its ongoing significance in our lives and in our country. The word "elect" comes from the Latin *eligo* or *electus*, meaning to call out, or to choose. In our current usage, it refers to a formal choice by the will of the people for a particular candidate. But in its broad usage, it can mean any choice or decision, especially one that carries some gravity. This is illustrated in the theological sense of the word: God's "election" of his people, his choosing them for salvation.

In this sense, the "election" is still ongoing, because we still have choices and decisions to make, ones that will affect us substantially as a nation. How do we move forward from here? How do we choose to relate to individuals on the other side of the aisle? How do we choose to love all men and women, despite our differences of opinions, values, and beliefs? None of these questions lend themselves to easy answers. Yet these are the choices that each of us must now make, and which we must encourage our political leaders to make. As for me, I elect the way of truth, justice, peace, and compassion. I elect the way of love. And I encourage you to do the same.



Catechesis Corner The episode of the widow's mite leads us, through Jesus' gaze itself, to focus our attention on a transient but crucial detail: the action of the widow, who is very poor and yet puts two coins into the collection box of the Temple treasury. Jesus is saying to us, too, just as he said to his disciples that day: Pay attention! Take note of what this widow has done, because her act contains a great teaching; in fact, it expresses the fundamental characteristic of those who are the "living stones" of this new Temple, namely the total gift of themselves to the Lord and to their neighbor. Regina Caeli Hybrid: emphasis on classics and Socratic seminar format; part in-school, part homeschool.

Each of the schools offer different music, athletics, and trade opportunities that may be a significant factor in your decision.


