WEEKLY REFLECTION

An Advent of Hope

Just what we need! If there was ever a time to need a savior, isn't this it? Even as so many have experienced emotions tending toward despair down through the centuries, we all need to feel for ourselves how Jesus the Savior who is to come supplies much-needed hope.

One sign of hope is that our church is still standing, still attracting over a thousand of God's children to worship and be reconciled here each week. It was heart-warming to see so many join us for our Thanksgiving Mass, allowing God to unlock both gratitude and generosity in our hearts by his grace. This church was built 100 years ago, starting with the basement, where Mass was celebrated for the first 20 years. December 14, 1924 was the dedication date of the church in the basement, now our parish hall.

As such, we have obtained a partial indulgence to celebrate the anniversary! The time frame is from noon on December 7 through the end of the day December 29: anyone who comes here and prays with the intention of receiving the indulgence, and prays for the intentions of Pope Francis and Archbishop Aquila, having gone to confession at least once during the days of the indulgence, and receives Holy Communion, can receive this partial indulgence for oneself or for souls in purgatory. A partial indulgence is the remission of a portion of a person's temporal punishment owed due to sin. This indulgence can be received once per day during the period. We will have an opportunity to pray for it together, such as during our parish retreat day on December 21.

Another sign of hope is the strength of the Church going into the jubilee year 2025. We see so many young missionaries from every continent taking their faith seriously. We see so many new programs of evangelization and spirituality that provide fertile soil for "cultural Catholics" to become intentional disciples, falling in love with God and serving his church, beyond the rote practice of faith. It is no accident that Pope Francis designated Hope as the theme for this jubilee. You can participate in special Masses at the Cathedral throughout the year and thus be a part of the jubilee pilgrimage here in Denver.

May God fill our hearts with an abundance of His hope this Advent and in the year to come!



100 Year Anniversary Indulgence

On December 14, 2024, we commemorate 100 years since the dedication of the lower church at this location, in what is now our parish hall. 19 years later, the present church was completed and dedicated. We have received a partial

indulgence designation (protocol number 2024-0611 AB A) for noon December 7-29, 2024 under the following conditions: once on any day that you come to Holy Ghost and receive Communion and also pray for the intentions of our Holy Father and the Archbishop of Denver, and go to confession during the period of the indulgence, you can receive a partial indulgence for yourself or souls in purgatory. An indulgence does not forgive sins, it removes temporal punishment due to our sins. A partial indulgence can be earned every day of the period.

We will acknowledge this anniversary during the Mother Teresa Social Ministry Christmas Party on the day (December 14), and also at the parish Advent retreat on December 21, during which we will lead everyone in the prayers to receive the indulgence that day (confessions will be offered, and the Masses before and after the retreat would count).


