WEEKLY REFLECTION

As we approach the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, it is worth reflecting once more on the season of Advent, and how we have been preparing for our Savior's coming.

Advent is all about preparation. One of the main ways we prepare for anything big is through *emptiness*. Not the kind of emptiness characterized by shame, loneliness, depression, or despair; but a fruitful, holy emptiness. We empty ourselves to allow for the coming of something greater. Think of the "silent night" on which Jesus was born. It was dark, silent, and still: empty of light, empty of sound, empty of movement. But that emptiness was so that it could be filled by the coming of something greater. Empty of light, sound, and movement, that holy night was able to welcome the Light of the world, shining brightly before all; the Word of God, spoken by the Father to give life to the world; and the Way, Jesus Christ, who descended from heaven to earth in the most sublime of all journeys.

Emptiness makes room for hope. It is very fitting that Pope Francis has declared 2025 to be a Jubilee Year of Hope, especially since there are so many places of emptiness in our world and so many signs of hope. Every baby born brings hope to a broken world that is slipping through our fingers. The conversions to deeper faith give us hope that all is not lost, looking toward eternity. Every need that is manifest and pulls at the heartstrings of one's neighbors stretches our hearts, making us to love more and thus to resemble God more closely, and this draws us all closer to heaven. This jubilee year is not an empty or merely wishful rejoicing but a very real liberation from what has oppressed us and a reclaiming of the best of who we are and what we have by God's grace. This grace is what fills our hearts, especially the emptiness of our hearts, replacing that void with all the fullness of God, born for us and all the world as our Savior and Redeemer!

Have a blessed Advent and a merry Christmas!

Catechesis Corner This Christmas is special because the Jubilee Year (celebrated every 25 years) will begin Christmas Eve and conclude on January 6, 2026 (Feast of the Epiphany). This was officially proclaimed by Pope Francis in his papal bull titled *Spes Non Confundit* which means "Hope Does Not Disappoint." It is customary that holy doors will be designated to enter through during this Jubilee Year, first in Rome and then in each diocese of the world. Holy Doors of the 2025 Jubilee of Hope in Rome will be located at the four papal basilicas. The first

Holy Door will be opened by Pope Francis at St. Peter's Basilica on Christmas Eve to usher in the Jubilee Year worldwide. As Pope St. John Paul II stated, "To pass through that door means to confess that Jesus Christ is Lord; it is to strengthen faith in him in order to live the new life which he has given us."


