WEEKLY REFLECTION

Saint Joseph

This Wednesday we will celebrate the Solemnity of St. Joseph, husband of Mary and foster-father of Jesus. One of my brother priests once related the shortest and most powerful homily he had ever heard about St. Joseph. Just fourteen words long, and punctuated with two dramatic pauses, it went like this:

"Saint Joseph was a righteous man.

Are you a righteous man?

And why not?"

To a group of priests and seminarians, these words cut deep. We want to be righteous men. We *need* to be righteous men—good, holy, loving men—if we want our priestly ministry to be fruitful. The same goes for husbands, fathers, and single men as well: We need to imitate St. Joseph in holiness and righteousness if we want to be fruitful in our vocation.

St. Joseph is the model for all men, in any vocation or state in life. He is our model for obedience and docility to God's word, for decisiveness and courage in carrying out God's will, for purity and chastity in our relationships, for selfless and generous service in support of a family, for hard work in a flawed economic system, for trust in God when human wisdom fails, and for a happy death in the company of Jesus and Mary. He is a model for husbands, fathers, priests, religious, and single men. So whatever your state in life, and wherever you find yourself, go to Joseph. Find in him the model for how to overcome your current struggle, with the help of God, and imitate his virtues as you live out your vocation.

Catechesis Corner

"And behold, two men talked with Jesus, Moses, and Elijah, who appeared in glory and spoke of his departure, which he was to accomplish at Jerusalem" (Luke 9:31). These two men, whose lives on earth had been separated by 700 years, are here to stand in symbolically for the Law and the Prophets: the Old Covenant giving its stamp of approval to the New.

What does it mean that Moses and Elijah spoke with Jesus "about his departure?" The Greek word translated here as departure (exodos) is the same term used for the departure of the Hebrews from Egypt.




This year, Faith Fridays are Marian! We will focus on deepening our conversion and Christian life by
