WEEKLY REFLECTION

Rejoice! I insist!

"Keep calm and brew on" or whatever the t-shirt says. "Don't worry, be happy," they say. "Rejoice in the Lord always; I say it again, rejoice!" St. Paul exhorts us (Phil. 4:4).

Yet in a time of suffering, try as we may, we even find it hard to crack a smile at a joke that used to have us rolling on the floor laughing (rofl for the millennials reading).

Resolutely, Holy Mother Church proclaims this Sunday of Lent as rejoicing Sunday (Laetare in Latin). Others have received their definitive forgiveness and healing; yours is coming soon. Whether you just lost a loved one, received a diagnosis of serious illness, accompany a distressed family member, lament a loved one's departure from the faith, or just crashed a car, there is still a God who loves you and reassures you that there is a paradise beyond this world. A place where He redeems and glorifies what pained us in this world as a testament to His power that supersedes the messiness of our lives.

Meanwhile, Holy Mother Church calls us to ongoing conversion. Right in the midst of the calamity, repent and believe in the Gospel, let your eyes be opened, run home to our Heavenly Father who runs out to greet us and so desires to restore our dignity.

This joy is not shallow. This joy is deeper and more abiding than the fleeting sorrows of this passing world. This conversion that God's grace inspires, especially in a time of distress and sorrow, means more to us for the rest of our lives. And this joy is what we show to each other to prop up our suffering neighbor who has not plugged into this joy or discovered how much our hearts are made for Him.

Encourage someone to confession, invite a friend to the Stations of the Cross, but most of all, share your story of grace, forgiveness, and communion with our God. This, truly, is cause for rejoicing!




Weekend and Weekday Masses & Church Functions Location: 19th & Welton ("Lighthouse Lot")


