

WEEKLY REFLECTION

The Joy of the Ascension

If I were among the eleven disciples at Jesus's Ascension into heaven, how would I feel? The Gospel of Luke relates that after Jesus was taken up into heaven, they "returned to Jerusalem with great joy, and they were continually in the temple praising God." Yet, at the same time, I imagine this joy was bittersweet, mitigated by the somber reality that Jesus had once more left them alone.

In this sense, Ascensiontide is an echo of Holy Saturday, that day of great emptiness. Christ had died, and his disciples had to grapple with feelings of sorrow, despair, and uncertainty as they waited for his resurrection. They were truly empty that day—emotionally, psychologically, and spiritually—barely clinging to the thread of hope they still had in Jesus.

The Ascension also left the disciples empty in a sense, but it was an entirely different kind of emptiness. Yes, Jesus was gone, and the world was "empty" of his presence. But this emptiness was a fruitful emptiness: an emptiness filled with hope, expectation, and ardent desire for what is to come. Jesus was going to heaven to take his seat at the right hand of the Father, where his divinity could fully manifest as he interceded for his Church. And as he ascended, he gave his disciples the promise of the Holy Spirit, who would bring to fulfillment all that he had taught them.

Even as the disciples probably experienced some bittersweet sorrow at the thought of saying farewell to Jesus once again, this sorrow was completely overshadowed by the joy of hope. Something new and powerful was about to take place; who would not be filled with joy and excitement at the thought?


Weekend and Weekday Masses & Church Functions Location: 19th & Welton ("Lighthouse Lot")


