

WEEKLY REFLECTION

The Mystery of the Holy Trinity

No mystery is more fundamental to our faith, nor more mysterious, than that of the holy Trinity. We know the basics from the creed and from our catechism classes: There is one God in three Persons, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. God is both one and three, yet God is not three separate gods. The three Persons are coeternal and coequal, of one divine essence; yet they are distinct, known as such by their relations with one another. This is a great mystery, entirely sublime and impenetrable to human reason, which we know only because God has revealed it to us. But how are we to make sense of it?

Various analogies have been used in the past to help explain the Trinity. St. Patrick famously compared the Trinity to a shamrock, which is one plant with three connected leaves. Yet this falls short: each leaf is only part of the plant, not the full plant itself. The Trinity has also been compared to a man who is simultaneously a father, a son, and a husband—one being with three distinct relations. Yet this falls into modalism, which imagines God as a unity who interacts with the world under different guises (modes). We can exhaust the tradition of the Church in finding different analogies, but they will all have the same result. Each analogy communicates something about the Trinity—and perhaps helps taken together they can aid us in understanding the mystery more deeply—but they are extremely limited in their helpfulness. Any analogy we can formulate by human reason and in human words necessarily reveals a far greater gap in our understanding, than it does the truth of the mystery.

The impenetrability of the mystery of the Trinity, however, should not drive us to despair that we cannot possibly know God. Instead, it should be a cause for adoration, and an invitation to prayer, study, and contemplation. Our God is so great and glorious that His essence cannot be comprehended by humans, and the friends of God have the joy to spend all of eternity getting to know Him in his blessed infinitude. Let us praise God the Trinity, and adore Him in the mystery!


