## WEEKLY REFLECTION

#### Corpus Christi

This Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi for short) is a profound day to reflect on several layers of meaning here.

Of course, we can contemplate the Eucharist in itself – the sacramental presence of Christ on Earth, confected by the priest celebrating Mass. It connects us to Christ's sacrifice and brings us into Communion with Him and with each other. It is the sacrifice of thanksgiving that pleases God. It remains present after Mass to be adored, whether in the tabernacle or in solemn Eucharistic Adoration, exposed in a monstrance.

The other major meaning is that we are the Body of Christ. The Mystical Body of Christ on Earth is the Church, of which we are all members. This means both the universal Catholic Church, with all of its Rites (e.g. Syro-Malabar, Chaldean, Byzantine, Maronite, etc.) and the particular Church (e.g. Denver, Santa Fe, Omaha, Salt Lake City, etc.).

It is so vital that we always see both what we hold in common and what differentiates us, and see that, in obedience to Christ through his vicar on Earth, the Pope, the authentic variety of the worship of God can be recognized.

Today, we go out into the streets of our parish in solemn procession. This is a little experience of carrying our identity as the Body of Christ wherever we go. With the Corpus Christi procession, we hope to sanctify a few blocks of our official parish territory by carrying Our Lord as we go and persevering in prayer.

I frequently tell couples at their wedding rehearsal that, kneeling before the altar at the Consecration, they will be closer to the sacred action in the Mass than ever before, to the point of seeing their own reflections in the chalice. Perhaps we can strain this hard to see ourselves in the chalice of the Lord's most precious blood. Perhaps we can see how He is redeeming us and inviting us into a deeper and more abiding Communion with Him that overcomes all that offends Him and that would be an obstacle to that communion, namely our sins.

Beg the Lord today to increase our faith and devotion to His Most Holy Body and Blood, that we may never offend Him, but rather praise, reverence, and serve Him, all the days of our life!

In his beautiful traditional hymn, "Adoro te Devote," he writes, "I devoutly adore Thee, O hidden Deity, truly hidden beneath these appearances. My whole heart submits to Thee, and in contemplating Thee, it surrenders itself completely. Sight, touch, taste are all deceived in their judgment of Thee, but hearing suffices firmly to believe...."




