

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Saints Peter and Paul

The feast we celebrate today has a special meaning for me personally—I was baptized at Saints Peter and Paul parish in Loretto, MN. And so, in addition to the importance of this feast in the Church and of the two Saints we honor, it's also a reminder for me of my own Baptism.



This connection is not incidental either. In Baptism, God had already placed within me the seeds of His plan for me, for my vocation (cf. OMV Formula of Profession). My vocation is to be priest of the Catholic Church: to be entirely obedient to the Magisterium, represented by St. Peter; and to embody the evangelistic zeal of the missionary Church, represented by St. Paul. We cannot have one without the other: There can be no Magisterium if the Church does not continue to evangelize all peoples, and there can be no fruitful evangelization if it not rooted in the truth of the Gospel as interpreted by the authoritative Magisterium. This is we celebrate Peter and Paul together, as the two pillars of the early Church: "Christian tradition has always considered Sts. Peter and Saint Paul to be inseparable: indeed, together, they represent the whole Gospel of Christ." (Pope Benedict XVI)

Today, all Oblates of the Virgin Mary around the world renew their Oath of Fidelity to the Magisterium. We are forever united with Peter and his successors, and we profess that we will never believe or teach anything contrary to the teaching office of the Church. We also see this as a starting point: that from the solidity of our faith, we must go forth. We must be witnesses to the Gospel of Christ; we must share that message with all who need to hear it; we must evangelize the masses who do not yet know the surpassing love of God in Christ. Today, let us all (not just Oblates!) be united in our profession and in our missionary zeal.


