WEEKLY REFLECTION

What a whirlwind Easter season!

As soon as Easter was over, we were in the Divine Mercy novena, celebrated Confirmation and First Communion with some make-ups last weekend and this Saturday; and this weekend we wrap up the final 2 of the 13 weddings slated for the Easter season. During this time we also had several infant baptisms and continued to hear hundreds of confessions.

This is the Church alive and at work, and it takes all of us – dedicated clergy and faithful laity.

As we commemorate the church going out from being locked in the upper room, upon the infusion of the Holy Spirit, we at Holy Ghost are also called to go out. Our budget outlook is grim. Many pews are empty; we could fit the entire weekend attendance at 6 Mass times into only two seatings of the church. So should we cancel 4 Masses and lay people off? No. We should go out and find the ones the Lord wants to join us here so that we broaden our base of support while staying on mission as a church!

I want to organize two different efforts to raise awareness of this house of God and community of faith that we love so much. First, prayer walks downtown. These could be candlelight rosary walks or some other form. We would take different routes to be visible to different people, and we would carry information about our church including some regularly-scheduled welcome events that help explain the Mass and give an introduction to who and what we are before inviting people to experience a Mass here. These prayer walks would also help sanctify downtown, fighting crime, showing that people care to be downtown and use these spaces for good. Second, promotion in the apartment buildings in our parish territory. The same information could be placed in the leasing offices for new tenants so their Catholic residents could get connected as soon as they move in and know that a Church stands ready to receive them. Both of these efforts would require a group willing to host this front-door ministry and informational meetings. Please let me know if you want to help refine these ideas that our pastoral council and finance council have been working on, and especially if you and your family can help, even on a rotating basis.

The Holy Spirit urges us to persevere in the practice of our faith, both in private, and to manifest the reasons for our hope as we make our life's journey. Let's go!






