WEEKLY REFLECTION

7 Years

Just as Fr. Jonathon celebrated his first year of priesthood last Sunday, tomorrow, Monday, August 4, marks 7 years since my ordination as a priest. It has been an incredible adventure!

I remember well picking out vestments out of the bishop's trunk at the rehearsal, and how the midday sun poured down on the altar as I stood beside the bishop saying the same words I had practiced but that then took on divine power to consecrate the Eucharist.

I remember the first time I sat for regular confessions at St. Mary's in Alton, IL, my first assignment, a couple weeks after ordination. I had heard a couple confessions already, but I was nervous about the words, about how to deal gently and clearly with whoever came in and whatever the person would say.

And then the priesthood just became my whole life. No longer Brother or Deacon, but Father. Beacon of hope even with no solutions or answers.

Lately, the thing too many people have said to me recently is, "You're only one person." So, if you would like to adopt a program here, please do! I love being a part of everything, but when more and more things depend on me, we're in trouble.

The other response to that is: we need more priests! Unfortunately, we can't get them delivered overnight. It takes a couple years to foster a vocation to the moment of entrance (I needed 7 years before entrance, and 8 years I the oven), and then all the years of formation, presuming the man actually has a vocation from God and perseveres. It is imperative, therefore, that every man who is called to priesthood respond. And it takes our prayers before, during, and after ordination for these vocations to flourish. Join us for our monthly First Friday holy hour for vocations at 6:30pm (we just had one), and consider joining the OMV St. Joseph Vocation Society with your pledge of prayer.

I am so honored to serve here as a priest of Jesus Christ and someone called Father – to God be the Glory!


