

#### **WEEKLY REFLECTION**

#### St. Francis of Assisi

As I'm writing this, the Church is celebrating the feast day of St. Francis of Assisi. St. Francis is known for many things, perhaps most of all his love of nature and creation. After all, he is the patron saint of lawn ornaments and bird baths! Just kidding... but he is in truth the patron of animals, the environment, and ecology. This love for creation displays itself most evidently in Francis's "Canticle of the Sun," in which he sings God's praises through the voices of all the elements of the created natural world.

Besides this spirituality of creation, Francis is also known for his deep love of poverty. Like a medieval troubadour or knight enamored with a Lady, Francis and his followers sought to court Lady Poverty, whom they felt was worthy of their courtly romance. This can sound very odd to many of us. We spend our lives seeking to avoid poverty however we can, rather than pursuing it. Here Francis shows his wisdom: Perfect joy cannot be found in wealth or possessions, but in the heart that has stripped itself of worldly rejoicing in order to seek the Beloved. A man who is truly in love with a woman would gladly give up a lucrative career in order to marry her; St. Francis simply applies this analogy to Poverty itself, which brings us face to face with Christ who made himself poor for our sake.

To imitate St. Francis, we need not renounce all of our possessions and live in the woods like hippies. Rather, for most of us, we can imitate his spirit through *simplicity of life* and *appreciation for God's creation*, which lead us to deep love for God. Reject unnecessary luxuries which distract you from the poor Christ, recognize the free gifts the Lord gives to all of us through the beauty of creation, and find your perfect joy in Him alone.


Support Floral Arrangements on the High Altar
