

# **WEEKLY REFLECTION**

#### All Saints and All Souls

This weekend we celebrate two major liturgical feast days: All Saints' Day (Nov. 1) and All Souls' Day (Nov. 2). On All Saints' Day, we venerate those who already share in Christ's glory in heaven, whether known or unknown, formally canonized or not. We do not pray for them, since they are already in heaven (the Church Triumphant), but we ask them to pray for us who are still here on this earth (the Church Militant). On All Souls' Day, it is the opposite: we pray for those who have gone forth from this life but who have not yet reached the ultimate destination of heaven. These souls are in purgatory (the Church Suffering), undergoing their final purification and enlightenment so as to be suitably prepared for eternal beatitude. We do not ask them to pray for us, but we pray for them, that they may soon reach that perfect happiness of the saints.

Often, however, we confuse the spiritual meaning of these two days. When a loved one passes away, our immediate response is to assume they are in heaven with the saints. This is a comforting sentiment, one which allows us to process the grief of loss. However, it is dangerous to presume this. First of all, it fosters spiritual laxity: If everyone goes to heaven, what need is there for ongoing conversion and repentance? Secondly, it makes us forget to pray for the deceased: It is a sacred duty of charity and a spiritual work of mercy to offer prayers for those who have died. Thirdly, it replaces true hope with a cheap counterfeit: The theological virtue of hope trusts in God's mercy for the salvation of others, whereas presumption lacks any solid grounding. In short, we do not presume to celebrate our deceased loved ones on All Saints' Day (with few exceptions), but we pray for them on All Souls' Day. And this is not cause for despair or anxiety regarding their eternal salvation, but rather an opportunity to grow in trust in the mercy of God.




#### **Introduction to Christian Spirituality**
