

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Throughout the past week, we have been praying for *OMV* vocations, and in particular for Zach Smith, a second-vear postulant with the Oblates. Please enjoy this brief letter of introduction from Zach.

Hello, Holy Ghost Community!

My name is Zach Smith, and I am a second year postulant with the Oblates of the Virgin Mary. My first introduction with the Oblates was when I was a student on a FOCUS mission trip to Chile. Fr. Tom Carzon was the chaplain on the trip. I remember working with him to build a small chapel in a remote farming community. Little did I realize that within the next two years, I would be living near the Oblates, as I would be sent as a FOCUS missionary to Bridgewater State University in Massachusetts, where the Oblates have their formation. Through my next three years as a missionary, I grew in friendship with both Fr. Paul Kallal and Fr. John Luong. And as I looked to what was after my time as a college missionary, I choose to discern the priesthood and religious life with the Oblates.

Growing up in Michigan with my younger sister Alexis, I remember days when our family would be camping at various state parks with friends during the summers. Naturally these trips made me now enjoy any activity outside, like backpacking and mountain biking. Throughout my years I was blessed to go to Catholic school up until college. At Michigan Tech I earned my degree in computer engineering, and I was taught there how to pray with the scriptures. And the witness of the Catholic community inspired me to live a more Christ centered life.

When I started serving full time as a missionary, for the first time I really had to ponder for myself the answers to questions like, "Who am I?" and, "God, what do you want me to do with my life?" I needed a lot of guidance in the spiritual life. The Oblates helped to guide me. Slowly, I grew in greater trust of God's mercy and his good plan for my life. In the summer of my second to last year on FOCUS staff, I went on an eight day silent retreat and felt the call from Jesus to follow him more closely. Thus far after my first year of formation, I have been so grateful for this journey and for the wisdom I have learned in my philosophy studies and the many graces from God.




