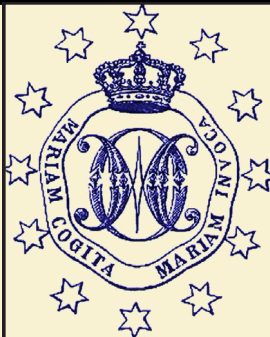

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Life

...is sacred. Any color, any age, any health condition, before and after birth, and even in death.

And yet how often does our society give free license to undermine, devalue, and trample that God-given dignity.

This week, as in most years, we commemorate both the civil rights activism of Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and the anniversary of the landmark Supreme Court decision in *Roe v. Wade* of 1973 that made abortion more accessible across our land, especially targeting people of color. In the wake of the Dobbs decision in 2022 (when I was making my administrative visit to Denver to prepare to become pastor here), each state is determining how abortion may still be accessed or not, and whether the state constitution will assert a right to procure abortions or to provide taxpayer funding for the procedure, as ours has now done.

Furthermore, we find ourselves in an atmosphere of asserting the rights of citizens over foreigners to the point of an absolute exclusion from "our" land. Is it because of a hated or feared color or language or creed? Is it because of an economic threat of too many workers and insurance claims to pay and mouths to feed?

We cannot avoid the political landscape in which we find ourselves. At the same time, we are not completely obliged to play by the rules that have been set by sufficiently powerful people up to this point, when those rules breach God's law. However, we should be prepared to suffer man's consequences for breaches of man's law.

Next Saturday the 24th, the Archdiocese is offering a retreat to educate us on the landscape of assisting immigrants – the foundations in Catholic Social Teaching, and the reality of the law and its enforcement today. Check it out at St. Catherine of Siena parish.

Above all, our calling is to holiness, as we hear throughout the readings this Sunday. What does it mean to be holy with respect to today's politics, on the national, state, or local levels? What does it mean to be holy in the realm of our families, our workplaces, our schools, our businesses? Love and care. Put effort into determining what is just. Be generous. Seek peace. And walk humbly with your God.

Then the glory of God will radiate from your life!

Catechesis Corner Corinth, a city on the Isthmus of Corinth in Greece, was of great importance in the ancient Roman world; its strategic location with three harbors made it a hub for trade and commerce, contributing to its wealth and regional influence. The city's prosperity attracted people from different backgrounds and cultures.

The Apostle Paul spent 18 months in Corinth during his second missionary journey, and both Jews and Gentiles believed his message about Jesus. These new believers became the Corinthian church, and the New Testament letters of 1 and 2 Corinthians are letters that Paul later wrote to these believers.

Corinth's strategic location contributed to the spread of Christianity. The establishment of a thriving Christian community in Corinth served as a catalyst for the spread of the faith to other parts of Greece and beyond.

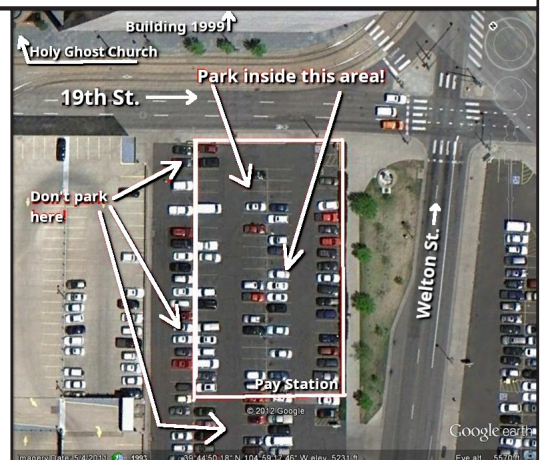
