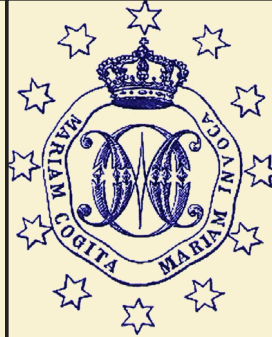

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Anchors

First, Safety and Vandalism. You must have heard of a string of vandalism of churches and vehicles from mid-November to mid-January in our neighborhood. CBS Colorado and Westword Magazine have both covered the story, and we are a part of it. We hope justice will be rendered for the man in custody who seems to have done most of it. We also renew our commitment to safety through vigilance and shared responsibility here as an anchor of security for our community. Anyone who would like to be a part of our church safety efforts (physical safety and medical response) is welcome to a meeting with our ushers and safety staff this Saturday, February 7 from 10am-12:30pm, lunch included.

As we move toward the penitential season of Lent, God's providence gives us a reminder of how to focus in our troubled times, in our own land and the world over. The bishops have repeatedly signaled when entities of whatever size cross the line of what should never be done. When we see evil in the world, the first call is to our own repentance, that we might celebrate our triumphs over temptation and lift each other up. This resolute turning toward the Lord anchors us. The next is to love our neighbor in concrete action, becoming an anchor for the neighbor. You make your determination whether that means prayer, becoming educated about the status of immigrants' rights under the law of this land or according to the Social Doctrine of the Church, participating in a demonstration you agree with, contacting legislators, or assisting the needy and marginalized yourself. What is certain is to uphold the God-given dignity of every human person, lest we forfeit our integrity.

Archbishop Aquila has called for a Holy Hour for Peace to be offered in every parish over the next couple weeks. Due to prior commitments, we will observe our regular First Friday Holy Hour this February 6 at 6:30pm as a time of adoration praying both for peace in the world and for an increase of vocations, especially to the Oblates of the Virgin Mary. First Fridays are traditionally for making reparation to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus for our sins and those of the whole world, which is a completely fitting intention at this time. Please join us for this special evening of prayer to be anchored by Jesus in the Eucharist.

Our help is in the name of the Lord, who made heaven and earth!

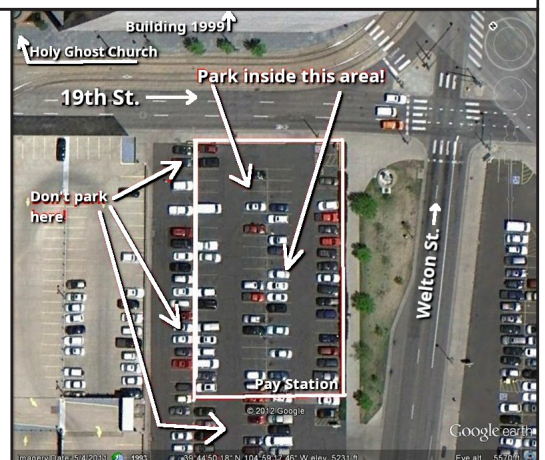
